Moon Farm 12th May - Canoeing 19th and 26th May

Dear Scouts and Parents

Next week (Wednesday 12th) we will be going out to Moon Farm for our meeting. This will allow us a bit more space for games and to learn how to use axes and saws safely. We will meet at the Rugby Club at 1830 and return to the Rugby club at about 2115. You do not need to wear full uniform but please wear some warm clothing, boots or strong shoes and your neckers. Depending on numbers we may need help with transport so please ask your parents. Attached is a permission form for the evening. Please ensure it is completed otherwise you will not be able to attend. If the weather is bad we will have the meeting at the Rugby Club at the normal time.

The following 2 Wednesdays (19th and 26th) we will be doing Canoeing at Burrow Farm and putting up tents at the Rugby Club. To give people the maximum time possible canoeing on the water, we will be splitting the Troop into 2 groups. For those canoeing we will meet at the farm at 1830 and finish at the farm at 2100. To get to the farm take the road from the Square through Essington (towards the surgery) and up the hill. Just before the Pig Stud turn right across Staddon Moor. At the end of the long straight bear right towards Burston and Bow. Burrow farm is the second farm on the left after about ½ mile. There is parking immediately past the farm house in front of 2 large barns.

Please bring your permission form, £2, a drink, clothing (including shoes) for canoeing and a change of clothes for when you get wet. It will be cold after so please ensure you have a towel and dry clothes to change into. Please remember that we are using the lake with the kind permission of the farmer and be on your best behaviour as we will want to use the lake again. If you are unable to get to Burrow Farm under your own steam please contact me for alternative arrangements.

For those putting up tents we will meet at the Rugby Club at 1930 as usual.

Please remember that we have a coffee morning on Saturday 22nd May. We will be meeting at the Town Hall in Uniform at 0945 and will finish about 1200. Please bring a cake (preferably home made), a raffle prize and something for the hamper. Don't forget to invite all your family and friends to come along and spend money in aid of Scout funds.
